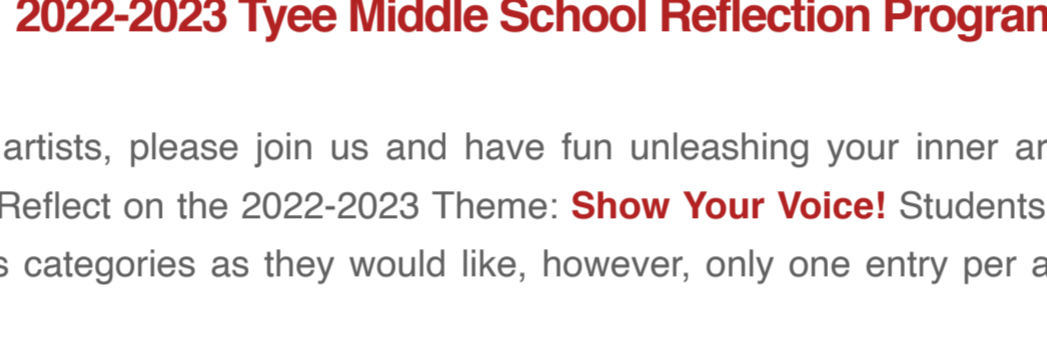


Tyee Bucks Fundraising

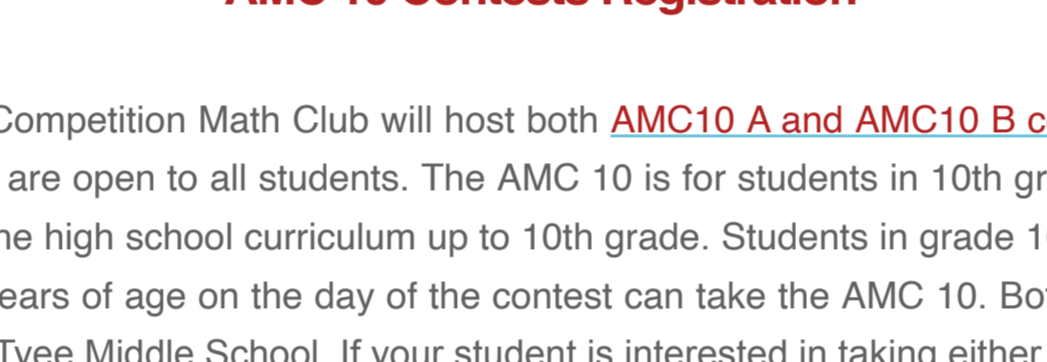

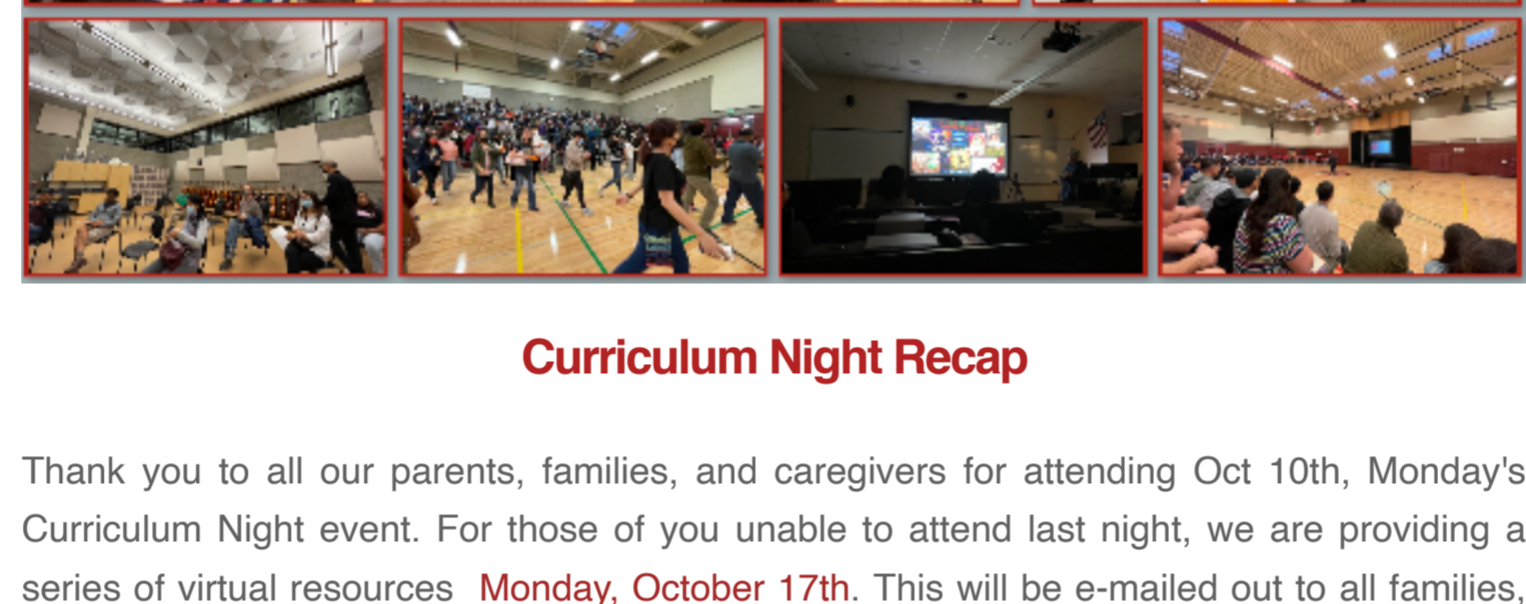
AMC10 A : Thursday, November 10th, 2022

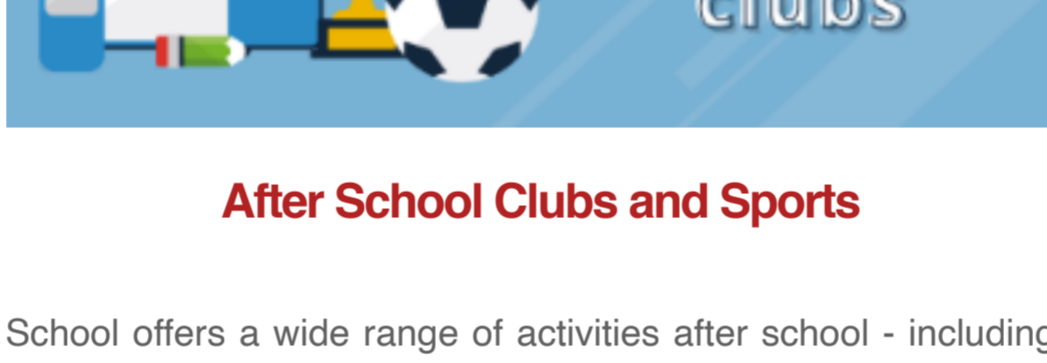

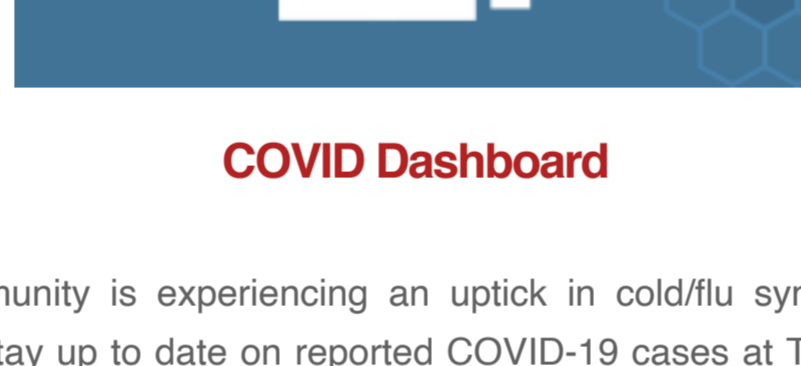

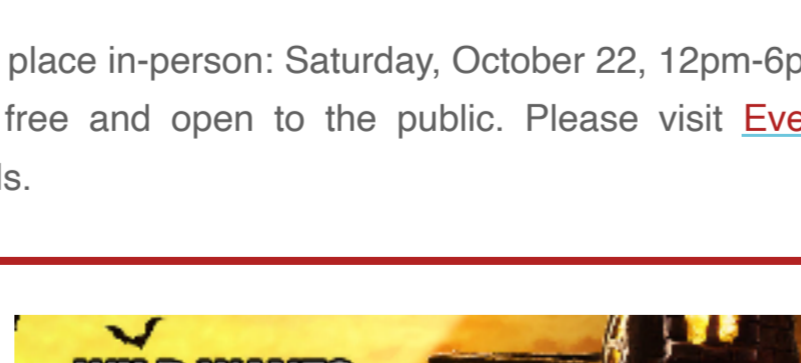
