

- In the Junior division, Jasmine Zhan, Emily Sheng, Ruthann Wang, and Kate Pyon finished second against 29 other teams.
- Lily Wang is our state champion Junior Scenario Writer, and Eesha Parihar captured second place in the Middle Scenario Performance competition. Ted Yun took home a trophy for 3rd place in that category.
- Max Zheng placed 3rd in individual middle level problem solving, and Claire Zhang finished in the top 7 in Scenario Performance.
- Olivia Sun and Siddharth Asnani took home 4th and 5th place in Junior Scenario
  - Writing, and Claire Zhang finished in 4th place in the middle division of Scenario Writing.
  - Our high school coaches Trinity Yun, Breanne Ng, Carol Gong, Sophia Lin, and Edie Tehan all did extremely well. Trinity Yun, Breanne Ng, Carol Gong, and Sophia Lin came in 4th in the state as sophomores competing against juniors and seniors, and Edie Tehan finished in 2nd place in Scenario Performance.


