There are some larger amount requests to discuss.
 - Grant request: Translator devices needed for MLL students (\$3837.50, for 27 devices 25 students, 2 teachers).
 - Student Biology book (\$2600.00, 74 students) Qn about student biology book these are books of notes that the students made during the year. Students made the textbook and they put the materials and contents into the book. She wants to print that out for the students to keep and use as a reference in high school.
 - Yan Talk to Mr Lillie in Jan and see if there are more applications.
 - Stella see if Ms Williams is ok with the biology book.
 - Can we add back in the Microscopes request from Ms Williams for \$6300.
 - Check if they have priorities for different items and prices. We should spend the money down in the bank.
 - Sandy I agree with Elizabeth see if telling them we have the reserve and what else can we spend on and what are the priorities.
 - We will ask Ms Williams re microscopes. And she submitted the staff lounge refreshment. This will be the fundraising goal for the Maker's Market in April. We think we can raise \$2k for that. PTSA funds should be more towards the students' benefit. Discussion on making sure we spend the large surplus down.
 - Ask Mr. Lillie if there is any necessary equipment needed by him that the Tyee PTSA can fund.
 - Still need a plan for accounting for this surplus funds. Maybe each budget year
 we can plan to spend slightly more expense over the revenue so we can drain
 down the funds each year.

 - Next one is 1/19 all school movie night. Meeting with Sirisha Tadapalli tomorrow. She wants to take charge of the Maker's Market.
