# 2. Approval of Minutes

Minutes for Sep 6<sup>th</sup>, 2023, BOD meetings were approved.

## 3. Treasurer's Financial Report – Treasurer(s)

- Changed the Tyee PTSA bank account signers to the new President, Co-President, and Treasurers.
- Sept financials: sent out bank statements and reconciliation reports
- Not many expenses so far. Revenue side: Olympiad brings more revenue; Tyee bucks expected to raise more than the budget.
- Expenditure changes include addition of staff appreciation meals. June staff lunch (\$2k coded to last year's budget) and new school year staff lunch.
- Total amount raised so far this year: as of Sept 30, 2023 raised \$32k, including company matches (\$1394) which is \$2k more than the budget. Also includes \$4k from Spiritwear. Most was from Tyee Bucks (\$26k). Goal for Tyee Bucks is \$35k not including company matching.
- Program revenue received \$15k of the \$30k budget.
- Membership fees on track to receive membership fee budget.

Had the principal meeting last month from Mr. Lillie. Heard that either Tyee is having a new bigger coffee machine. Not sure if there is a need for this coffee machine.

#### 4.3 Reports from

- Ways and Means Jenny:
  - Keep going the same as last year. Have Goodwill x 2 fundraisers.
  - Thinking about restaurant fundraisers e.g. Chinese restaurants, Indian restaurants - ask restaurants to give 5%/10% to Tyee if we have families visit them. Lalitha and Jenny to meet and sort out the details. Lalitha has some Indian restaurant connections.
- Programs Lalitha:
  - All clubs are going ok except for the Spelling Bee club. We don't have a chair for the Spelling Bee club.
- Communications Peggy
  - No updates yet.
- Membership Tracy (not present)
- Grants Yan
  - Yan made a flowchart for the grants process.
  - Is there a deadline for approval or reimbursement. Yes end of May.
- Student Socials Elizabeth
  - Will have the meeting with Mr. Lillie next week to confirm dates.
  - 2 dances slated; potential addition of Maker's market. Will have dates for everything after she meets with Mr. Lillie.

#### 5. New Business

## 5.1. Propose to open CD account for the PTSA funding repository

• 5% APY. Right now all the cash is on a checking account, not much interest earned. Sarah made a motion to 7 month CD for \$100k for 4-5% APY. Xiao Second. Motion passes unanimously.

- Stella did the PTA training last month.
- Yan Xiao and Ting will rotate attending the Bellevue PTA Council meetings monthly.

# 5.7 Staff Appreciation Chairs present a Plan of Action (POA) for budget approval.

- Valeri sent a survey to teachers to look at options to provide coffee to Tyee Staff. 25
  responses (25%) specified a specific machine. Some teachers emailed Valeri saying that
  they need coffee for those big meetings to get coffee made quickly. Tyee has a coffee
  machine right now to make coffee but you need your own pot.
- Seattle company provides a full service coffee machine \$300-500/month based on usage. Vendor is offering a free pilot for 1 week to try and see. Mr. Lillie is supportive of trying it out. The company provides different kinds of coffees and hot drinks including cups. We could survey the staff after the 1 week trial. Other machines looked at included the Delonghi True Blue, Moka master
- Board brought up that we don't want to do the trial without having the money to support it as staff may expect the service after the free trial ends.
- Valeri suggested doing the trial so we are informed by data. However if the staff like it, then it would mean less staff appreciation meals.
- Valeri thinks we could stay within the \$6k total budget so long as monthly or special staff appreciation meals are reduced by the cost of the coffee service.
- Sarah IRS has guidelines for a maximum amount/percentage (5% of total expense) to go towards hospitality and staff appreciation.
- Vendor could come by Tues to look at the space.
- ACTION: At the next general meeting, we need to approve a budget amendment to add a new line for Staff Appreciation and set the budgeted amount to a maximum of \$6k.
   Add the staff appreciation into the budget expenses \$6k

## 5.7 Discussion and suggestions on what to do re unspent funds raised

- Xiao right now we will be in deficit of \$6k without the budget amendment.
- BOD has the capability to move the general funds around can we repurpose other items.
- Sarah suggested calling for a budget meeting earlier like in November. Sarah also said we should spend the extra funds on things that the teacher needs for the kids/classroom.
- Elizabeth maybe we should also make sure that we spend the extra funds in the bank account. Could we use the extra funds in the account to add into the teacher grant money and increase that budget?
- Lesley we should funds that we raised but didn't spend and be able to spend that in the next year. Otherwise we risk raising funds each year but the kids whose parents donated that money will not be able to benefit from it.

- Elizabeth in the budget we need to show the unspent funds. Board discussed how this
  could be done. One proposal was to change the the Teacher Grants POA so that it has an
  income line to make the teacher grants balance. Name it a new income line item like
  General Repository. Or run in the red such that we can allocate and spend the rollover
  funds from last year.
- Lesley suggested adding a line item in the balance sheet where we carry over the unused money from the previous years. We need to do our books so that we show the carryover.
- Stella proposed we continue discussion in the emails for this.

- Goodwill fundraiser provide snacks for volunteers
