Room Placement Exam

Format

- 45 questions, 15 minutes
- Separate test for each of 5 Science Bowl subjects
 - Earth and Space
 - Energy
 - Life Science
 - Math
 - Physical Science
- General Rules
 - 1) Scratch Paper OK
 - 2) No calculator, other devices, etc
 - More specific rules provided in email and before test
- Scoring System

Outcomes

- Top 15 students placed in Room 1
- Another 15 students placed in Room 2 and go on to Room 3 and 4
- For students who don't take the placement test, coaches will place them in the Rooms based on availability

- Encourages improvement
 - I didn't make Room 1 but I want to be on a science bowl team...
 - I made Room 1 but I need to continue studying to be placed on a science bowl team...



- Aids in team placement

Outcomes

- Team 1: Top student(s) in each subject
- Team 2: Next best students in each subject
- Team 3: Remaining students
- Hoping to send all 3 teams to science bowl
 - Will register teams in order of Team 1, Team 2, then Team 3
